- Introduce the Poland's economic diplomacy the Economic Cooperation Department of Ministry of Foreign Affairs is responsible for (DWE MSZ)
- Introduce the Information Point for International Public Procurement (PARP)
- > Discuss a scope of WB, IFC and AIIB work, e.g. investment, advisory services
